MINUTES OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Harper called the meeting of the Eatonville Town Council to order at 7:00 p.m.

**ROLL CALL**

Interim Town Clerk Kathy Linnemeyer called the roll. The following were:

Council member **Valentine** made a motion to excuse Council members Bowman and Schaub and was seconded by Council member **Pierce**. All were in favor.

- a. Police Report- Chief McGuire said the surveillance cameras have been installed at Town Hall and the Police Officers are paying to have the Police Department sign in front of Town Hall replaced.
- b. Public Works Report- Town Planner Nick Bond gave a brief report on the status of Eatonville's Comprehensive Storm Water System plan. Town Administrator Doug Beagle informed Council that the lagoon liner project has started.
- c. Committee Report- Council member Valentine reported that the Finance Committee met on July 17<sup>th</sup> and discussed changing back to admin fees, cost allocations, reviewed financial reports and will meet again on July 24, 2012 to discuss budget amendments. The committee has reviewed the reserve policy and is planning to have our first reserve transfer in September. At the request of the Mayor, the Finance Committee will be more involved in the budget process this year.
- d. Mayor's Report- Mayor Harper read the memo dated July 16, 2012 explaining the Xpress Bill pay EFT payment processing discrepancy of transferring money into the main checking account.

An Ordinance of the Town of Eatonville, Pierce County, Washington, relating to funding for general maintenance and operation costs with property taxes; providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the Town at the statewide general election to be held November 6, 2012, A proposition authorizing the Town of Eatonville for a special excess levy to cover general maintenance and operation costs; providing for severability, ratification of past consistent actions, and an effective date.
