

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-17
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND
ORDINANCE NO. 2005-9

WHEREAS, the Washington State Growth Management Act permits municipal adopted Comprehensive Plans to be amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville, having updated its Comprehensive Plan in 2005 finds that it is in need of updating, based on new and best available information; and

WHEREAS, the Eatonville updated Comprehensive Plan in Section 5.4 provides a public procedure and process for amending the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, a number of Comprehensive Plan amendments were proposed as permitted in Section 5.4; and

WHEREAS, the Eatonville Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Eatonville Planning Commission has researched and evaluated all the proposed amendments and is recommending to the Eatonville Town Council that the Comprehensive Plan be amended as identified below:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Eatonville adopts the following:

Section 1. Section 10.5.1 and Table 10-2, page 10-6 of the Town's Comprehensive Plan are amended to extend the population forecasts to include year 2030, to read as set out in Table 1, Appendix A to this Ordinance.

Section 2. Sections 10.7.9 and 10.10, pages 10-16 and 10-22, and Figure 10-4, page 10-23 of the Town's Comprehensive Plan are hereby deleted from the Plan.


Section 3. The urban growth areas as shown in the current Comprehensive Plan on Figure 10-1, page 10-2 are amended as shown in the following attachments to this Ordinance:

1. Appendix B: Figure 1, Proposed Urban Growth Boundary, Ohop Valley
2. Appendix C: Figure 2, Proposed Urban Growth Boundary, Barney's Corner.

Section 4. If any section, sentence, or clause of this Ordinance is ruled invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portion of this Ordinance shall remain valid and be in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


