

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-24**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE,  
WASHINGTON FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2012**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Town of Eatonville, Washington, as follows:


